

C'fld hires new library director

The Chesterfield Township Library Board has hired a new director for the local township library. Marion Lusardi is scheduled to take over as the director of the Chesterfield Library October 7, 1996.

"It just seemed like a wonderful opportunity," says Ms. Lusardi, on what prompted her to apply for the position.

Lusardi replaces Gail Hardenbergh who officially resigned from the position August 28, 1996.

Chesterfield's new director of the local library earned a Bachelor's degree from St. Mary's College, Notre Dame in Indiana. She obtained a Master's degree in Library Science from Wayne State University.

"I have a lot of experience with electronic referencing," notes Lusardi, on one of the attributes she brings to Chesterfield.

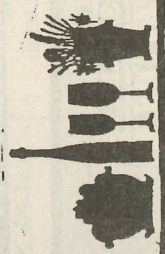
